Dear parents, carers and children,

This week has been a busy one, with lots of outdoor learning, even in the 'summer rain'! Children are benefiting from the social, collaborative challenges, from genuinely learning from trial and error, and from their mistakes. These important 'growth mind-set' skills are vital for secure learners. Mrs. Boxall has successfully launched our new Forest School area, thanks to the PTA for providing a trolley and outdoor camping WC & tent. The area is safely fenced and has already provided lots of exciting learning opportunities.

Preparations for our end of year events are well under way, and, as per this morning's letter, we will be relying on your support to enable these to go ahead safely and successfully. There are likely to be further adaptations over the coming weeks.

In the classroom, we are working hard to consolidate learning and to make sure children are ready for the transition to their next classes. Children's reading appears to remain strong, and they are developing the grammatical, punctuation and structural skills which have been weakened by the school closure. They are working hard on maths with lots of application of maths skills evident, although we feel there are areas where we will have to focus on strongly next year in order to cover all the required learning. Despite missing significant 'chunks' of learning over the past fifteen months, children are beginning to use mathematical and grammatical vocabulary more confidently once again. Having discussed this with other schools, there are many similar experiences, with schools finding that we have not the same amount of 'work'/'outcomes' in order to make judgements we would usually make about progress and achievement. We will explain all this in a few weeks, when we make our reports available to you.

Our lost property bin is full again with many items of uniform that is not named. If unclaimed, this will be donated to the Bag 2School Scheme.




Car Parking - Permits
