Dear Parents and Carers,

We have had another hot week but our lovely old building and the hats and sun lotions you have been so vigilant with have made it possible to work comfortably and to be outside safely at playtimes. Thank you. Despite the heat, we are all continuing to work hard on the basics of reading, writing and maths, with some super pieces of writing and some excellent problem solving in maths this week. 


