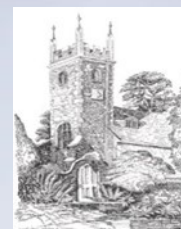

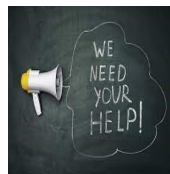
Costumes for the show!
