Most parents and many school grown-ups are largely unaware of the potential dangers for our children and also for those moving onto secondary school. Please do put this date in your diaries and attend if you possible can - it is well worth the cost of a babysitter/ the disruption to your day to attend.



We will send more information home about this over the next couple of weeks, so please look out for this. It IS relevant to you, no matter how old your child is.
