This week has been exciting for us as we had our new Clevertouch interactive TVs installed in Chestnut, Apple and Maple classrooms. We have been looking forward to the numerous learning applications and hope that they will help us use I.T. even more effectively. Beech Class have been using theirs for a while now and find it a powerful resource,

significantly better than our old interactive whiteboards, espe-


Please could we ask that one parent or carer only comes onto the playground at drop-off and pick-up times.


