Focusing on one of the poorest areas of Africa, Sierra Leone; their work building schools, providing uniforms and making school furniture not only gives the children of Sierra Leone an education but gives jobs to the local people. Penelope regularly visits our school to give us updates on progress and the class have the opportunity to speak to the children they are helping. The children will get to see exactly where the money is being spent and how it is helping the community. We hope that this will become a long term link between our school and Education West Africa.
