# Staffing News: appointments

I am delighted to inform you that we have offered a permanent, full time teaching position to Miss Ashton, one of our interviewees from last Thursday, and she has accepted. Miss Ashton is familiar with the school from work experience here, prior to her teacher training: now that she has qualified and had some teaching under her belt, she is well placed to come and join our team. Our plan is that Miss Ashton will take over from Miss Hall when she leaves, and that she will join us for some transition activities and sessions over the coming months. She was a firm favourite for the post with our skilled and demanding pupil parliament interview panel, and we are excited to welcome her to school.

We are in the process of finalising a further appointment, which will bring added expertise in the Special Educational Needs area of our school, and a pair of experienced and able hands to work alongside Mrs Johnson in Beech Class. These appointments will take effect from September, but there will be some transition work before then. We will confirm this next week, as our appointments, although highly beneficial, will stretch our staffing budget! Our governors and I are in agreement that the investment in additional quality staff is worth every penny, and I am sure you will all support us in this.

# Staffing News: A sad loss to our team

I am extremely sorry to bring you the sad news of the loss of Gill Garfield, who passed away this week. Gill, wife to Keith (our premises officer) and grandma to Harry in Y6, has been a willing and valued volunteer in the school for many years, throughout her granddaughter Molly's time with us and up until the present day. We all feel her loss keenly and extend our love and condolences to the whole family. Keith hopes to come back into school on Monday, when we will provide him with plenty to do as usual, and wrap him and his family in the love of the West Dean School family. I know that you will join me in this—he will not want any fuss but appreciates all the warm wishes from everyone.

The children will miss Gill greatly—she was a generous, kind, nurturing, creative soul, who never wanted anything in return for the time and energies she gave to support our pupils, the community café, the after school craft clubs, the school library etc etc. Please do discuss this with your children at home if you feel it appropriate—we have talked about human frailty and end of life in our assembly, when we wondered 'Where do we go when we disappear'. (This is a lovely book which asks lots of open-ended questions and allows for individual interpretation). Gill was such a caring person: there will be a place in heaven for her and we will pray for her in her final resting place.




Year 6 children at Oakwood mini-Olympics.
