September Plans

Currently, we have a draft timetable in place which allows all children to be in school, all day, each weekday. This follows the current guidelines from the DfE, WSCC, Public health England and the teaching unions. The restrictions in the current guidance are considerable and will impact greatly on provision in the classroom, but also on our lunchtime, arrival/departure and playtime arrangements. We have some options for this, but will wait until closer to the start of term before we finalise our plans.

We will probably be asking YR, Y1 and Y2 pupils starting school around ten minutes later than KS2 (Beech and Chestnut) classes. Similarly, at the other end of the day, we will probably ask KS2 pupils to leave ten minutes later than younger pupils.

More information will be available at the end of August/beginning of September, as we will continue our decisions and planning during August, responding to the national and local situation. Thank you for your continued patience and understanding throughout these changing times. We will confirm arrangements with you as soon as is practicable—we do not want to publish plans only to change them at the last minute!


