

The provision for booking and paying for clubs for the second half of the summer term is now available on our on-line payment system www.schoolmoney.co.uk. You will be able to book clubs for half a term at a time.

We are pleased to continue to offer a wide range of after school clubs, including sports, gym, cookery, French, art and crafts and our new Spanish club. We are also able to continue to offer our violin/viola club for the children already having lessons in school. Alex Urquhart will be arranging this on a Friday afternoon, following on from the children's lessons. The dates will coincide with our club dates and will not be every week.

Mr Johnson will be continuing our new 'Change for Life' club which will incorporate sports and nutrition and general tips on how to have a healthy lifestyle. Cookery club will also continue on a Wednesday. NB: Cookery and Change4Life will only run for 4 weeks as we have other activities on 3 of our Wednesdays. You will find attached a club timetable with details of each club, which year groups are invited, costs and

timings etc.

Please note the dates of the clubs as they do not run every week.

Reminder: Children should not use their school PE kit for clubs; they will be required to get changed into home clothes, to ensure PE kits are always available for lessons.

Each club, apart from Cookery and Change4Life, will run for a block of 5 weeks and will be charged according to the cost to school. Due to significant funding changes it has become necessary to increase the cost of the clubs slightly, to ensure that we cover our school costs, but, I'm sure you will agree, they still represent good value for money giving the children a wide range of opportunities outside the curriculum.

Clubs are available to book and pay for on-line at Schoolmoney.co.uk. The deadline for bookings is 9.00 on Monday 4th June. You will only be able to book and make a payment if there is a place available, places are allocated on a 'first come first served' basis, so please do book your places quickly if there is a particular club you are interested in, to avoid disappointment. If you use vouchers to pay for your club provision, places will need to be booked through the school office; please do contact us as soon as possible please.

Care bears is our after school care provision, open to all year groups every day between 3.00-4.00. These sessions are £5 per child per day and are available to book on school money. Please ensure that you have booked a place for your child, we get very busy and cannot guarantee places if children are not booked in. If you have booked a place and do not attend you will still be charged unless you have let us know that it is no longer required.
