Dear parents, carers and children,

Thank you for your support of our revised programme of Christmas events. Having spoken with some of you and received messages, it is reassuring to know that you understand and appreciate our approach during the run up to the Christmas break.

The Pupil Parliament had an extraordinary meeting this week to discuss the question of whether we should be more sustainable in the way we send Christmas cards this year, as some see it as a wasteful use of card and paper. They considered the following options:

- Restricting Christmas cards to one 'whole class' card per person
- Limiting the number of cards each person could send e.g. ten each
- Using another method of sending Christmas wishes e.g. Google Classroom
- Limiting Christmas card giving to within a child's own class

The MPPs discussed the balance of being sustainable versus allowing people to celebrate the magic of Christmas in a way that is personal to them. They also discussed how to encourage inclusivity in Christmas card giving, so that nobody feels left out. At the end of the discussion, the Pupil Parliament voted to suggest to families that Christmas card giving is limited to within a child's own class e.g. Beech to Beech only, Chestnut to Chestnut only etc. Please consider this request from Pupil Parliament when advising your child about card giving.

Following a successful interview process on Thursday, in which some of our children played a valuable part, I am delighted to announce that Mrs Emma Bowman has been appointed as our new Special educational Needs Coordinator from January 2022. Mrs Bowman is a very experienced primary school teacher and existing SENCO in two other local schools. Following many years in the classroom, she has chosen to specialise in Special Needs provision, so will bring a breadth of knowledge and expertise to the role from across three schools. Sharing expertise like this is a very sensible way for smaller schools to operate and we are all excited at welcoming Mrs Bowman to the West Dean team. During the remaining weeks of this term, she will be working with Mrs Totman to ensure a smooth transition in provision for our children.

West Dean enjoyed great success at the Year 3 and 4 Mixed Football tournament on Thursday. After some very closely contested matches with teams from other local schools, our children reached the semi-finals.

They narrowly missed out on a win in their final match, with a last minute 'golden goal' in extra time from the opposition. Nevertheless, from a field of fifteen school teams, this is a tremendous performance from our young footballers.

Well done team and thank you to Alex Langhein and Mrs Goacher for supporting and coaching the children at the tournament.



As you know, Beech and Chestnut Class have been learning to play the cornet this term, expertly taught by Will Wilkin from the West Sussex Music Team. As is tradition, the children came together in the hall yesterday to celebrate their final week of cornet learning with a performance. Under normal circumstances we would have loved you to join us for the performance; but do not fear - a film recording was made and is currently being edited together, ready to share with you soon. Thank you to Will for working with us, and a huge well done to all of the children for their focus and perseverance in getting to grips with quite a challenging instrument (I speak from experience having tried, and failed, myself at a similar age).

As part of their RE learning, the children in Beech Class have been comparing the two versions of the Christmas story portrayed in the Gospel of Luke and the Gospel of Matthew. They have also been considering how the incredible story of Jesus birth can become lost amongst all of the lovely, but not necessarily Christian, customs and popular culture of the season. It was interesting to listen to the children today, as they discussed this point and prepared questions to pose to Rev Sarah about the true meaning of Christmas. Do ask them about it; they are really knowledgeable and have some fascinating questions that challenge our own adult thinking.

With just two more weekends before we break up for Christmas, I'm sure life is becoming increasingly busy for you all. In between the preparations and busyness, do have a safe and relaxing weekend.
