#### Curriculum and Learning

All our teachers are working together to send home some resources for you to use to support home-learning.

This week, we are attaching some spelling activities. Other curriculum areas will be supported over the coming weeks. We are also trialling an APP for spelling in school - there is a cost to this and we are currently evaluating it as it would be £4 per year per pupils. Do let your class teachers know if you think a spelling app for home use is something worth investing in: we would use it in the classrooms too.

With spelling, remember that using joined, cursive writing really helps children learn the letter strings/blends/ prefixes and suffixes which make up words. Writing a word correctly, over and over again, in joined up writing, develops muscle memory as well as visual memory for the word.

Exploration of patterns and rules develops an understanding of how our language works. Learning lists by rote is generally much less useful.

	Please log-in to your account to make sure any outstanding balances are settled.				
Late Arrivals	Just to clarify our timings: from 8:20, we have two members of staff on the playground to supervise children, which means adults can leave from then onwards. Children come into the classrooms, ready to learn, at 8:35, when the bell is rung. At 8:40, the register is taken. Any children arriving after this time enter through the main school entrance, so that we can ensure we keep children safe.  From Monday 9th October, we will have a 'late arrivals' book in the entrance area so that we can log those children who are persistently late, as this will help to explain inconsistencies in the progress for some children, and is an important record of our attendance. Please do complete the 'late arrivals' book, giving the reason for your lateness. Please note that this is a parental responsibility.  Children should be arriving at school with an adult - they will not put their own names in the book -we will expect the accompanying adult to complete this, please. I have asked our office staff to ensure this is adhered to.  This enables lessons to be 'in full swing' by 8:45 at the latest, and means that we make good

#### Cormorants Swimming Gala

Usually, we ask the children to write our reports but Mrs Johnson and I wanted to write this one because we wanted everyone to know how very proud we are of all of our swimmers, both in training and their performances at the Chichester Cormorants Primary Schools Swimming Gala.

We will start by saying that 12 weeks ago some of our younger swimmers were only just managing to swim a width (12m) of the pool; not on Saturday -on Saturday, they raced 33m!

Please do not under-estimate what is required to be part of a swimming gala. First, you have to make sure your stroke is legal and you can swim it continuously for the length required (how many of you could swim 33m of front crawl, let alone 33m butterfly?), then you have to remember the rules for starts and finishes to ensure you are not disqualified and all your effort wasted. When you have mastered that, you have to learn all the whistles and commands to start a race, and to stay in the water until you are asked to get out; there are also the relay takeover rules to learn too! Then when you think you have learnt all that you have to be brave enough to stand alone, in your swimmers, in front of everyone, ready for your race – there is nowhere to hide!

All of our swimmers not only achieved all of the above, but did so with a huge smile, heaps of determination and an enormous amount of effort. Every single swimmer tried their hardest, but more than that, they showed great sportsmanship towards each other and other schools too – high 5-ing all the winners as they went past. Of course we went out to win, but it is much more than that; it is about having a winning attitude, about knowing that we were not going to win the event and still trying our hardest and doing our best and in the words of Charlie Gran and Jamie Edwards: 'We can't expect to win every year, it is great that Bosham have won – we will just have to try even harder next year!' Kitty Hogg said 'Everyone was amazing and I am very proud to be involved'

We came fourth this year. Bosham Primary School had a very well deserved win with Jessie Younghusband coming a strong  $2^{nd}$  place, The March School was  $3^{rd}$  and we were very close behind them, followed by St Richards and then the Central School.

We are continually grateful for the support from all the parents - 'Squad Training' couldn't happen without you giving up a Tuesday evening! - thank you so much. Also, a huge thank you must go to Mrs Cruttenden, Sebastian Hadnett and Jack Goacher for their help too.




