We marked the coronation of King Charles III during our Friday morning worship and Acorn

The children learned a little bit about the coronation ceremony, including the weight of the crown (2.2kg). Holding a 2kg weight in their hands, most children agreed they would not fancy wearing it on their head for very long.

The children then sang a special coronation song called 'Sing for the King' which speaks of all that unites us rather than setting us apart. An audio file of this song, recorded in worship this morning is attached to this newsletter. Rev Sarah finished our worship by leading us in this prayer for King Charles III.

As we write this newsletter, cakes are arriving and bunting is being hung for our coronation tea party. Thank you to our wonderful PTA for organising what looks set to be a lovely event.
