Late Arrivals	Just to clarify our timings: from 8:20, we have two members of staff on the playground to supervise children, which means adults can leave from then onwards. Children come into the classrooms, ready to learn, at 8:35, when the bell is rung. At 8:40, the register is taken. Any children arriving after this time enter through the main school entrance, so that we can ensure we keep children safe.
	From Monday 9 <sup>th</sup> October, we will have a <b>'late arrivals' book</b> in the entrance area so that we
	can log those children who are persistently late, as this will help to explain inconsistencies in
	the progress for some children, and is an important record of our attendance. Please do complete the 'late arrivals' book, giving the reason for your lateness. Please note that this is a
	parental responsibility.
	Children should be arriving at school with an adult - they will not put their own names in
	the book -we will expect the accompanying adult to complete this, please. I have asked
	our office staff to ensure this is adhered to.
	This enables lessons to be 'in full swing' by 8:45 at the latest, and means that we make good use of the time we have in school.
