Dear parents, carers and children,

We are all delighted with our return to school after the half term holidays: you will all no doubt know that the pool is open and most of our children have been in! Your children will also, no doubt, have told you about the fabulous playtimes we have had this week. On Tuesday, after a super Hugo assembly, the 'bubbles burst' and all children played together on the field and playground. The joy was tangible and the change in atmosphere has been remarkable. We have all learnt to appreciate being able to socialise and play freely, and this will now have a positive impact on children of all ages, as they mix, mingle, and learn from & with one another.

Our assemblies are still outside, and children will need to be seated on the tarmac for part of the time, so a **sweatshirt or coat to sit on** will be useful, please. We are in the midst of dance **and drama rehearsals** for our show and our **interviews for the Y5/6 roles in the Community Café** have taken place too. We are, however, beginning to do some singing in classrooms and in the hall, at times when the spaces will be vacated for sanitising—before playtimes and before home time—and with plenty of spacing and ventilation.

Our clubs are providing further opportunities for children to 'catch up' on some of the experiences we have all missed, over the past few months. Please do sign up for these as there are spaces in several of them and we need to keep them financially viable. Care bear club is now available each day, once again.

We very much hope that, once restrictions finally lift, we will be able to maintain all this provision, and build on it further. If you are available to support with swimming sessions in school, then we often need additional adults, to ensure safe ratios. No experience needed, as you will be an additional adult for that lesson.

### CURRICULUM NEWS

In addition to relaunching our **swimming**, **dance and drama** curriculum , our staff team have been analysing where we still have gaps in learning due to lockdowns, and we are targeting support in these areas. For many pupils, this will be in areas of mathematics, and in the technical areas of writing (use of complex punctuation and understanding the terminology of grammar, for example). We have also identified areas where we have not covered the same ground in the curriculum, such as in computing, history and geography—these will be 'gaps' for all our pupils. We are building as much of this learning into our coming terms, and will retain our high expectations. It is possible that your child will have a little support from our tutors over the coming weeks, where we have identified gaps, but this is a national initiative and nothing to be concerned about.

## Car Parking - Permits


