Dear Parents and Carers,

This week has seen the introduction of Forest School activities for this year with Mike Pearce, supported by our team. It was a beautifully sunny day.; children were able to enjoy and explore all that nature has to offer at West Dean School. In the first half of the morning there was lighting fire using cotton wool, dry wood and 'dragon snot'! There was a scavenger hunt collecting natural materials from the grounds.

After break Mikey read the children a book which was wonderfully illustrated showing the habitats of wildlife within the woods and the forest. The children then took inspiration from Artist Andy Goldsworthy who produces amazing art using natural materials such as leaves and wood.

The children used their scavenger items to create some spectacular art including Dogs, rockets and dinosaurs.. The sessions were finished with toasted marshmallows around the camp fire.... Delicious!!!

During the after school club the children came up with ideas for development of our own grounds in addition to toasting marshmallows on the fire.

On Monday, Chestnut and Apple Classes will enjoy similar outdoor learning experiences and we will continue to develop the

grounds and follow this up over the coming months. Mikey will return in January for a further two days and we are excited by our plans for the children.

Our School Parliament is how we achieve lots of things in school with the children. They input to this and so do staff. Things are achieved in partnership. We love to have governor and parent involvement, so if you would like to support one of our departments, (particularly the environment department where I know several parents have expressed an interest), then please do let one of us know.

Chess

Mr Chambers is running a lovely chess club where children are learning and playing against one another. If your child would like to try the game out, the website the club are using for their homework is ChessKid.com. and any child can join. We would not usually recommend any gaming sites, but this is a safe and friendly site where children can learn and play chess.

Their website says: 'We are committed to making sure that every child that uses ChessKid.com has fun and is protected!

It is a safe place for people to come and enjoy chess. We use strict privacy management tools on the site to make sure that all interactions are 100% safe. Members cannot send messages or custom text to each other unless they have both blind-friended each other. Blind-friending means that both members must independently add the other member as a friend, and members are not notified that another member has added them as a friend. This means that your child will only become friends with those on the site that he or she specifies. Also, as a parent you can review your child's friends, or prevent them from adding friends. Only friends are able to chat, send messages, and communicate'. It certainly seems a lovely way to practise the game even when you are not together.


CHURCH NEWS:
