Dear Parents and Carers.

I am delighted with the way the school year has

begun. Already we can see our new YR pupils learning the systems and routines in school, They are a very young group this year, but they are already enjoying books with other chil-



dren, counting and sharing, and are secure with their first sounds/phonemes. They are having lunch and socialising beautifully with the other children. Throughout the school, the classes are working hard, with Miss Ashton leading a very happy Y2 class and already producing some super writing. In Beech ad Chestnut Classes, the children have had their second week of learning the drums (djembe) with Kristian Baliiaka and are progressing really well. Our Y4 pupils in particular have impressed us by showing the Y3 children how things are done in K52, and in Chestnut Class the atmosphere is one of happy learning and respect, with some already very challenging work being tackled confidently by the children.

On Monday, Chestnut and Apple Class tried their hands at the Forest School activities. Everyone is very excited to see what we can achieve with our environment in the next few months. Our orchard is full of apples and we hope to harvest them for everyone to share next week.

We have had our Parent Information sessions for each class and hope that they were helpful. Do keep up to date with the learning by attending these as often as you can and by reading the termly letters from teachers, as we have lots of trips and activities planned.

Hugo Van Driel has visited us for an assembly this week and we will soon welcome other clergy to support us during this period of interregnum (whilst we are without a priest in the parish) including the Archdeacon of Chichester on 5th November.

We're collecting Team GB stickers with Aldi's Kit for Schools. (Please see attached information).




