Weald & Downland Open Air Museum - RSPB Day, Year 5.
On Tuesday, Year 5 went to the Weald & Downland for an RSPB day. We walked there from school and we saw lots of lambs.
As soon as we got there we went on a walk around the museum to see what birds we could see and hear. We saw these birds:
Rook, Wood Pigeon, Robin, Blue-tit, Chaffinch, Black Cap, male and female Blackbirds, Buzzard, Goldfinch, Great-tit, Wren, Pheasant.



We learnt about what the birds sound like and how they look. Some of the birds were very hard to spot. Rob (RSPB Instructor) told us a special word for a Robin, which was gregarious; this means that you are very good at talking to people and very lively.

After our tour of the museum we split up into two groups; one group was making bird feeders and the other group were writing a story together about birds.

We really enjoyed the day and I think I would be able to recognise some birds now if I saw or heard them.
