#### Dear Parents and Carers,

#### Sport Relief - Non-uniform Day

Thank you to everyone who supported us with our non-uniform day on Thursday: in response to a 'fast track' proposal through the new School Parliament, the Fundraising and Finance Department, led by Alex Wilburn, invited children to wear their own clothes and make a donation. The money raised from this was £130.00 and will be partially donated to Lizzie Williams, a Paralympian who visited us during our 'Alive & Kicking' week. Some of the money will go to Sport Relief and some will go into the School Parliament coffers to fund initiatives proposed by other departments.

We would really like to see as many parents as possible, to celebrate learning, to talk about your children's next steps in school and to discuss how you can support this at home. #### West Dean CE Primary School Council is evolving into a School Parliament.

You will probably have heard already about the working of the School Parliament so far (check last week's newsletter if you haven't heard about this!).

#### The five Departments are:

- Environment
- Curriculum and Learning
- Finance and Fundraising
- Healthy and Happy Lives
- Belief and behaviour

Each of these Departments will have certain roles and jobs throughout the year.

The **Departments** will make **suggestions** to the **Pupils' Parliament** of elected Year 6 pupils. These pupils will be 'in office' for half of the school year: September to mid February/mid-February to July. The **Pupils' Parliament** will then make '**proposals'** to the **Adults' Parliament**.

The Adults' Parliament will decide whether a 'proposal' is agreed in its entirety, if it needs any amendments or if it is not to be followed. All decisions will be ratified by the Adults' Parliament. You will see that we are aiming to replicate our country's parliamentary system in a child-friendly way.

As you may be aware, the monarch does have certain powers to intervene in this decision making process, and so the governing body, guided by me, will take this role!

We hope that you will soon see the fruits of our collaborations and that the children are soon talking knowledgably about this. You will see that the Finance and Fundraising Department have already 'fast-tracked' a suggestion through parliament, as they are required to hold the funds for all the other departments to bid to! So, there will be a non-uniform day and a sponsored Readathon - and that is just after our first meeting!

#### Books for School

We are delighted to be able to offer our £5 Book Tokens for you to shop for classroom library books with your child - pop into the office or email us to let us know you are planning a shopping trip and we will send a voucher home.

We will be holding a Scholastic Book Fair in school on Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> (Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> March, 3.00 onwards, to co-incide with Parents' Evenings. Please do come along and have a look at the lovely selection of books on offer. If you would prefer to spend your book voucher allocation at our Book Fair, please do let us know and we can make sure that you can make a selection for our library. This would also benefit the school because we can earn commission on books sold at the Fair which will enable us to choose additional books for our library.

#### West Dean School Parliament - Sponsored Readathon

Our newly formed School Parliament have met and our Finance and Fundraising Department have proposed that we hold a sponsored Readathon. This will encourage all of our children to read as much as possible over the Easter holidays in addition to raising funds for our School Parliament. Other Departments within the Parliament can then 'bid' for funding for projects that they would like to undertake.

All of our children are invited to take part in the Readathon and you will now have received your sponsor forms and book marks; children can be sponsored for reading a book, a chapter or 5 minutes per day, whatever is suitable for each child. You may like to read the book that has been chosen with the book token.



Chichester District Foodbank	Thank you to everyone who supported us with donations to the Chichester District Foodbank; we are going to continue to have a box in the Reception area to collect any items that you would like to donate and Mrs Jen Rogers has very kindly agreed to make
Parent & Carer Drop-in Sessions	regular deliveries of our goods.  Every Wednesday 3.00-3.15 - Pop in and see your child's classroom and have a look at their work. Teachers will be available every Wednesday for informal chats - do pop in. We would love to have the opportunity to share your child with you.
Care Bears	Care Bears After School Provision - this will run every day from 3.00-4.00.  Please make sure that you have booked for your required places through <a href="https://www.schoolmoney.co.uk">www.schoolmoney.co.uk</a> . Please make sure that you let us know, if you have booked a place and are collecting your child at 3.00, we are then able to release your Care Bears place to another child.
After School Clubs	Please do check the timetable for dates when the clubs will be running and for weeks when there are no clubs. Please also make sure that you have booked and paid for club places on schoolmoney.co.uk.
	Schoolmoney.co.uk on-line payments enables you to book for trips and clubs etc. and make payments on-line.  Please do log in regularly and check for 'live' visits and events.  Please log-in to your account to make sure any outstanding balances are settled.
Late Arrivals	Just to clarify our timings: from 8:20, we have two members of staff on the playground to supervise children, which means adults can leave from then onwards. Children come into the classrooms, ready to learn, at 8:35, when the bell is rung. At 8:40, the register is taken. Any children arriving after this time enter through the main school entrance, so that we can ensure we keep children safe.  From Monday 9 <sup>th</sup> October, we will have a 'late arrivals' book in the entrance area so that we can log those children who are persistently late, as this will help to explain inconsistencies in the progress for some children, and is an important record of our attendance. Please do complete the 'late arrivals' book, giving the reason for your lateness. Please note that this is a parental responsibility.  Children should be arriving at school with an adult - they will not put their own names in the book -we will expect the accompanying adult to complete this, please. I have asked our office staff to ensure this is adhered to.
	This enables lessons to be 'in full swing' by 8:45 at the latest, and means that we make good use of the time we have in school.  Late Collections  On a similar note, please ensure that you collect children on time after school and clubs. Our staff have many other responsibilities and are wasting valuable time waiting for children to be collected.
