Dear Parents and Carers,

What an exciting week we have had with some super Christmas treats as we move closer to the end of term. We had our very own theatre experience as Beech and Chestnut Class treated us to their play, 'Silent Night', which told the story of the writing of this much loved carol.

There was so much excitement in school and they performed extremely well for both their afternoon and evening shows. The staff team, led by Mrs Turner, did a fabulous job of preparing the children and we are grateful to many others, including Keith, Gill and Harry Garfield and Mrs Stone for ensuring we had such super costumes. The children were, obviously, the stars and we are really pleased to be able to give them so many chances to shine! We also raised £237 towards our new stage lighting with the sale of the very professional programmes which are a super souvenir of the show.

Meanwhile, Maple and Apple Class had a **theatre workshop** with the team from CFT, which they thoroughly enjoyed and did really well with. We hope to do some more drama workshops over the coming terms. Their visit to Chichester Festival Theatre to see **Mr**. **Popper's Penguins** was a treat and all the children loved it and behaved so well that we received compliments about their behaviour. Well done to the whole school for such a super week. Next week we have something festive happening every day, so do look carefully at the diary section to make sure you don't miss anything!

Apple Class assembly this morning was a joyful start to our day and we can see so much progress in a short time for YR pupils and Y1 too. Our Y6 squash players took part in a competition this week and are through to the finals which will be held next Tuesday.

Our week has ended with a violin performance given by Mrs Urquhart and all our KS2 children. In just one term, the children have learnt so much and we thank Mrs Urquhart for her work with them. We also celebrated another successful music examination result: Dylan joins Oscar, Noah and Sophie who already have 3, 2 and 1 grades, as he has just passed his grade 1 exam with a distinction! Our other clarinettists hope to follow in their footsteps next year. Our thanks go to Mrs. Schofield, who has supported them so well in their peripatetic lessons, which take place during school time and are proving really successful. It is wonderful to have so much music in school and we very much hope that some more children will take up peripatetic lessons. Mrs Schofield has some spaces in her timetable and would be able to teach clarinet and other woodwind instruments by arrangement. We would love Mrs Urquhart to become a more permanent fixture in school and hope that some of the children will choose to continue with the viola or violin. Emails directly to me (at the school HT email address) are far from guaranteed to receive instant responses as I am frequently in classrooms/meetings/on visits etc and do not always see emails on the same day: I am, however, perfectly happy to respond to emails when time allows!

Some parents have obtained teachers' own email addresses: this is not a manageable means of communication as we do not check emails during the school day when we are in the classroom teaching. In special circumstances, it may be appropriate to communicate directly by email in this way – this is up to the class teacher to arrange. However, teachers have been **directed** by me **not to respond to emails** outside the hours of 8.00-5.00pm, Monday to Friday. Please do not send emails to teaching staff outside these hours, as we need our staff to be rested for teaching and not up late at night responding to emails! Thank you for respecting our teachers' work-life balance and for your co-operation.
