APPLE AFFAIR

Thank you to everyone who 'maked and baked' for our Apple Affair stall. In spite of the poor weather on Saturday we were very well supported over the weekend and raised in excess of £3,000 for our PTA funds. We have a comprehensive spending plan for these funds and greatly appreciate everyone's support in helping us to raise money for additional resources, opportunities and activities for our children. It was a super community event, as always and we thank everyone for their contributions, even if it was spending money on the stalls! I would like to extend a personal thank you to the PTA committee and to staff for all their time, energy and hard work to make this an organing success. We will let you know what we are spending the money on over the next few weeks!

Please do put the class Open Morning dates in your diaries, as these are the best way to find out how we teach key concepts. Our Harvest Assembly will be held on Thursday 13th October at 8.45 and you are welcome to join us. We would like to ask children to bring in items that will then be taken to the Church for their Service on Sunday 16th October and then donated to Stonepillow. Our Reception children will not be taking part in the assembly as we feel that they are not quite ready for the big hall.

There is a lot of organisation required to co-ordinate all of our clubs and we do our best to ensure that children can attend the clubs they have selected. Please do support us in this by committing to their attendance and not leaving booking to the last minute. Please remind your children which clubs they are doing to avoid confusion at the end of the day. Care Bear Cub will be available every day, but places are not guaranteed and should be booked in advance. This is not a default club for anyone who forgets to collect their children!
