Dear Parents and Carers,

School is beginning to feel a little more 'normal' now that we have seen most of you a couple of times. We hope that you have all adapted well to this limited timetable—the children certainly seem to have enjoyed seeing their teachers and friends again, and they have all accepted the routines and restrictions really well.

New entrants Some of our new entrants (YR pupils for September) joined us for short introductory sessions on Wednesday (and more will join us next week, on 8th July), in 'buddy pairs'. This was a great opportunity for them and their grown ups to ask questions, familiarise themselves with the school environment and enjoy a little social interaction with their peers. They particularly enjoyed our new water play equipment.

Our wonderful office team will still respond to email queries between 9am and 12 noon, and there is someone in school from 8:30 until 3pm, but we are often busy and may not always be able to answer the phone immediately.

September Plans

You will, no doubt, be wondering what our plans are for the next school year, from September, and may have heard some of the government's latest guidance. We will publish more details next Friday, but want to reassure you that we do intend to open fully for all pupils. There will be restrictions and safety precautions in place. We will probably stagger arrival and departure times; after school clubs will be extremely limited and classes will be kept apart from one another.

Drop off and Pick up Times and Procedures

We need to keep groups of pupils and parents apart to reduce the risk of the spread of Covid-19. Please park at a safe distance from others and keep 2m away in the school grounds.

Parents should be able to park safely in the school car park, but if you can walk to school, please please do so, to avoid congestion. If you can park at the Dean Inn, and safely cross the road, this will help reduce congestion too.

Our staggered drop off and pick up timings will help us all to keep a safe distance and prevent families arriving together, queuing and mixing of groups. Please respect these timings. If you are very early, please wait in your car.

Please do not stand and chat on the playground as this will result in congestion—we would love to chat and catch up, but we will prioritise safety over this.

We cannot run after school clubs as we cannot mix groups. Our hours are limited so that all our staff can support us with sanitising and cleaning the school, as well as continuing to provide the high quality home learning resources, planning and support.


The settlement of any outstanding payments would be greatly appreciated, thank you.
