Dear Parents & Carers,

These sessions are so important in ensuring we are working together to give the children all the support they need in their learning and socially in school. You will probably be aware of some of the areas your child is working o: sometimes tackling one specific area of learning can unlock lots of potential!

Do remember that regular reading with and to your child, lots of mental maths activities, incidentally throughout the day (eq: how long is it until bedtime, how much will it cost if we buy two of them, why do you think this pan holds more than that one? etc) and simply talking with your children about everyday things or what is in the news will really help their learning. We are happy to advise if there are any queries and hope that you find the electronic report books and the meetings useful: it helps us to know if there are any changes at home too.
