### Dear Parents and Carers,

Important notice to Chestnut class parents re French Residential visit:

Chestnut Class WW2 Day: Year 6 children from Singleton School will be joining us when we have a visiting soldier to bring our learning to life on Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> February. They will be experiencing 'ration' packs and have the opportunity to try on battle dress in addition to having an interactive, historical insight into WW2.
