Dear Parents and Carers

Our Ofsted report is now finalised and we have shared some of the highlights with the children. This will be sent out later today, along with a letter regarding the inspection.

Our many strengths were noted during the visit and in the report, and we have some useful development points too. Some of our data has been close to average expectations, rather than 'significantly above', for the last couple of years, and this is something we are aware of.

Having an external view on how we can improve this has been useful, and our inspector was very thorough and insightful. This Ofsted inspection was under a very different framework from our 2009 visit, and a new framework will be in place from September 2019: again, you may find it interesting to take a look at the proposals for this. We are proud of the children and staff, especially for the 'outstanding' personal development, behaviour and welfare. Supportive parents and governors were mentioned throughout. Our 'Early Years' provision' has been highly praised and our school leaders (pretty much all of us!) 'produce far more than the sum of their parts!'

The report is well worth reading and we are already putting plans into place for the future, and breathing a little easier now it is over for a while!

Next week is a busy one, with Maple Class assembly (with our new cordless microphone!) and culminating in the Valentine's Day Community Café: we hope you will be able to join us.

School Events this week: Four children visited Chichester Cathedral with Mrs Chambers on Monday for a literacy afternoon: this was a visit which really got the children thinking! . 
