#### NUT CLARIFICATION

We have really appreciated everyone's support in making the school safe for all the children - there are two children with nut allergies in school: they are allergic to two different sorts of nuts. We are, therefore, asking that you do not allow any food where 'nuts and peanuts' are labelled as ingredients. This labelling is usually very clear, and in bold.

If packaging is labelled as "may contain traces of nuts" or "made in a factory where nuts are used", then this can be brought into school.



I am pleased that our grown ups and children are now much more aware of this potential hazard, even though it may mean buying peanut butter alternatives for some of us!

#### MATHS

Mrs. Johnson and I have now got most of the maths initiatives in place. 
