Measuring the World's Largest Fish

This week, the children brought their learning to life by measuring out the average length of a whale shark on the playground. At an average of 12 metres long, and with a mouth measuring around 1.5 metres wide, the children were amazed by its enormous size and could clearly see just how big these gentle ocean giants really are.

Staffing news

It is with very mixed emotion that I have some staffing news to share.

After many years of truly exemplary service, Mrs Chilton has informed me that she will sadly be leaving West Dean at the end of this school year, having decided to take early retirement.

We know this has been a difficult decision for Mrs Chilton, but we also know it is the right time for her and her family. She will leave very big shoes to fill.

In the summer term, there will be plenty of opportunity to say a proper goodbye to Mrs Chilton, as well as to thank her and celebrate all she has achieved during her time at West Dean. I am sure you will all agree that a more caring, loving and diligent teacher you will not find—and the good news is that we get to keep Mrs Chilton for another half a school year, so it's not goodbye yet!

This will of course have an impact on our staffing structure for September 2026; please be assured that there is already detailed planning in progress for how this will look. Further detail will be shared in the summer term.

In other news, after discussion with the Bishop Luffa Learning Partnership leadership team and Trustees, it has been determined that West Dean should have a Deputy Headteacher. As well as this being of clear benefit to the strategic development of the school, there are times when the headteacher is off-site and decisions must be made by a member of staff authorised to deputise. A recent example of this was just last week when the cut in the water supply caused the sudden need to close the school.

With the above in mind, we are taking a two-phase approach to appointing a Deputy headteacher. I am delighted to announce that Mrs Sarah Johnson has been appointed as Acting Deputy Head for an interim period. Mrs Johnson will continue to work 4 days a week in Chestnut Class, and will also become more involved in the operational and strategic direction of the school. Mrs Johnson is not only a very experienced teacher, but has also completed the National Professional Qualification for Senior Leadership (NPQSL), so is more than qualified for this role.

Subject to the positive impact of this interim role, in the summer term, there will be a full recruitment process to appoint a permanent Deputy Headteacher.

Congratulations to Mrs Johnson – we are all looking forward to working with her in this new way.

A roll of liners to get you started



An outside food waste recycling bin which we will empty weekly



What you can recycle

You can recycle all your food waste, including the following:

When collected separately, food waste can be treated via anaerobic digestion where it will be used to generate natural forms of energy such as biogas and bio fertilisers. This is a much more efficient and environmentally friendly way of processing your food waste.
