

Why your support matters





Yr 1 **Harrison** - for your enthusiasm in our topic and the effort you put into learning! Keep it up!


Yr 2 **George** - you showed some excellent manners this week., holding the door open for teachers. In class, you have done some super factual writing on the whale shark. Keep it up!
